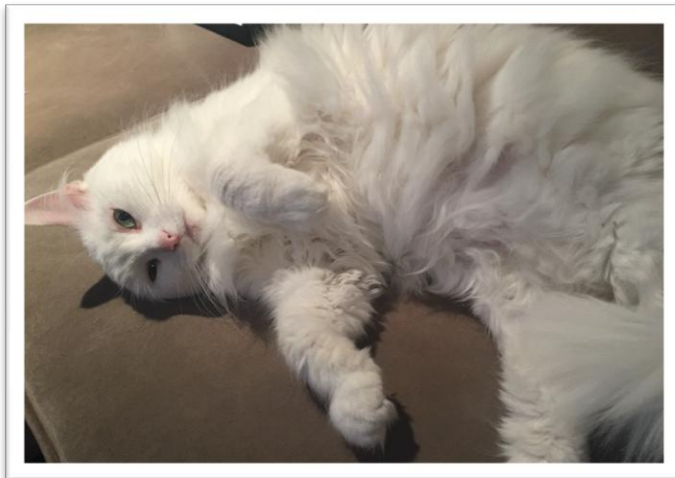
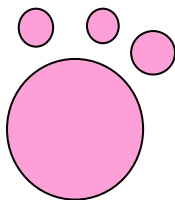
Wonderful, gently used items for sale! Proceeds from items sold go to the shelter

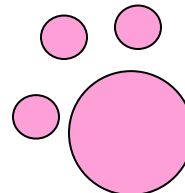

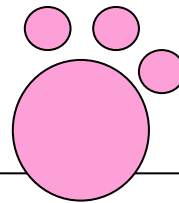
Above: Shylo, adopted from the shelter this spring and happy in her new home.

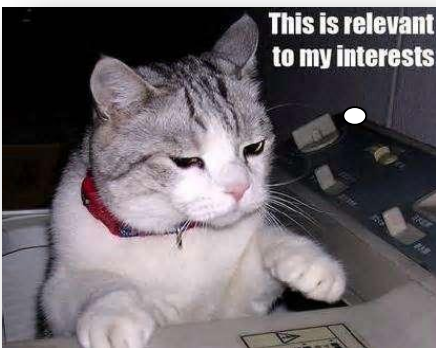

REMEMBER!!!

The heat affects your pets just as much as it affects you. Heat can be very dangerous to an animal's health, so always be mindful of how much heat your pet is exposed to. Pay attention to physical or behavioural changes in your pet – these changes could be a sign that the heat is affecting their body.

Never leave an animal in a hot car or building and always have water on hand when your pet is outdoors.
